Rules & Regulations Point Score Booklet

Effective from 1st July 2016

1. INTRODUCTION

The South Australian Management Council Awards are a scheme designed to recognise consistent, meritorious and versatile performances by South Australian, Australian Stock Horses in competitions.

Certificates and Trophies are awarded at two levels for each of the 7 sections over a period of 12 months (July through to June) – that is, a Merit Award and a Champion Award. A further Supreme Versatility Trophy will be awarded for horse/rider combinations that achieve Champion Status in 3 of the 6 sections and a Best Performed Youth Award based on overall performances in any nominated section/s.

2. ELIGIBILITY FOR NOMINATION

- 1. Stud Book, Second Cross, Special Merit and First Cross horses may attain points from the date of registration as Australian Stock Horses, and owned or leased by a member who resides in South Australia and is a member of either the Central Branch or South East Branch of SA.
- 2. Breeding Purposes Only horses will not be eligible to be nominated for SAMCA.
- 3. Horses other than registered Australian Stock Horses being ridden by children under 13 years of age are eligible for Nomination and can be ridden in Branch Events*
- 4. Minimum Age Restrictions:
 - a. Led Classes 4 years and over (3 years and under points accumulate in Young Horse section)
 - b. Ridden Classes (excluding Classes listed in part c) 2 Years (or as outlined by governing competition bodies)
 - c. Dressage, Eventing & Showjumping 3 Years
 - d. Young Horse 3 Years of age and under for the year of nomination
 - e. Youth Rider ASHS member aged under 18 years for the year of nomination

Acceptance of nominations is subject to:

- Horse owner must be a Financial Member of the Society who is a member of either the Central Branch or South East Branch of SA
- Rider must be a Full Member, Youth Member or Youth Participant Member
- Payment of the specified nomination fee
- Approval by SA ASHS Management Council

3. CLASSIFICATIONS OF SHOWS/EVENTS

All horse Shows/Events are broadly classified and listed into 3 grading's:

NOTE: For the purposes of this clause, whether or not a Show/Event is of good repute shall be at the sole discretion of the SAMC.

GRADE 3

- ASHS National Championships
- ASHS State Shows
- Royal Shows
- National Competitions
- International Competitions

GRADE 2

ASHS Branch Shows

GRADE 1

- Agricultural Shows & Breed Shows
- EA competitions
- Other State Championship Competitions
- Events of good repute

4. EVENTS AND RULES FOR EACH SECTION

Events such as Progeny Classes, Pair of Hacks, Rider Classes, Turnouts and Horsemanship events are not acceptable for SAMCA (unless otherwise noted in the rules).

4.1. LED/HALTER

General Rules

- Performances attained in events restricted to other breeds or registries are NOT acceptable. ALL
 performances must be attained in events open to any breed, or restricted to ASH only
- Points may only be claimed if a ribbon or prize is awarded
- Events for youth, junior, juvenile and the like are not acceptable under this section
- Results from Led section of Futurities, Maturities and Challenges are not acceptable under this section
- No additional points will be granted for Supreme Champion
- The 5 Bonus points for the Highest Placed ASH awards are only awarded in events open to any breed

Events in which Led/Halter Section points can be obtained are:

• All Led Classes with the exception of: Progeny Classes, Foal Classes, Weanling and age 3 and under Classes, Best Presented Classes and Led Sections of Futurities, Maturities and Challenges

The Grading's are as indicated in Section 3 of this booklet and the point score system is available in the individual point score table in Section 12.

4.2. SHOW

General Rules

- Performances attained in events restricted to other breeds or registries are NOT acceptable. ALL
 performances must be attained in events open to any breed or Restricted to ASH only
- Points may only be claimed if a ribbon or prize is awarded
- Events for youth, junior, juvenile and the like are not acceptable under this section
- Results from Show Hack section of Futurities, Maturities and Challenges are not acceptable under this section
- Age restricted hack and ridden classes are not acceptable under this section e.g. horse 3 years and under
- No Additional points will be granted for Supreme Champion
- The 5 Bonus points for the Highest Placed ASH awards are only awarded in events open to any breed

Events in which Show Section points can be obtained include the following:

- Hack/Hunter Classes
- Pleasure Classes
- English Attire
- Curb Bit
- ASHLA * (sub section of Show section with separate Trophy)
- Stockman's turnout

The Grading's are as indicated in section 3 of this booklet and the point score system is available in the individual point score table in Section 12.

4.3. CATTLE

General Rules

- Performances attained in events restricted to other breeds or registries are NOT acceptable. ALL
 performances must be attained in events open to any breed or Restricted to ASH only
- Points are awarded for placing in finals only, not rounds
- Events for youth, junior, juvenile and the like are not acceptable under this section
- The 5 Bonus points for the Highest Placed ASH awards are only awarded in events open to any breed

Events in which Cattle Section points can be obtained include the following:

- Campdrafting
- Station Cutting (Two Handed Cutting)
- Team Penning
- Lady Rider * (sub section trophy will be awarded)

The Grading's are as indicated in section 3 of this booklet and the point score system is available in the individual point score table in Section 12.

4.4. PERFORMANCE

General Rules

- Performances attained in events restricted to other breeds or registries are NOT acceptable. ALL
 performances must be attained in events open to any breed or Restricted to ASH only
- Points may only be claimed if a ribbon or prize is awarded
- Events for youth, junior, juvenile and the like are not acceptable under this section
- Results from Led and Show Hack sections of Futurities, Maturities and Challenges are not acceptable under this section
- Age restricted working and ridden classes are not acceptable under this section e.g. 3 years and under
- No Additional points will be granted for Supreme Champion (if awarded)
- The 5 Bonus points for the Highest Placed ASH awards are only awarded in events open to any breed

Events in which Performance Section points can be obtained include the following:

- Working Classes
- Utility Classes
- Station Horse Classes
- Time Trials

The Grading's are as indicated in Section 3 of this booklet and the point score system is available in the individual point score table in Section 12.

4.5. MULTI FACET

General Rules

- Performances attained in events restricted to other breeds or registries are not acceptable. ALL
 performances must be attained in events open to any breed or Restricted to ASH only
- Points may only be claimed if a ribbon or prize is awarded
- Events for youth, junior, juvenile and the like are not acceptable under this section

- The 5 Bonus points for the Highest Placed ASH awards are only awarded in events open to any breed
- Futurity results do not count under this section please refer to the young horse section.

Events in which Multi Facet Section points can be obtained include the following:

- Maturity
- Encourage Challenges
- Open Challenges

The Grading's are as indicated in Section 3 of this booklet and the point score system is available in the individual point score table in Section 12.

4.6. SPORT

General Rules

- Performances attained in events restricted to other breeds or registries are not acceptable. ALL
 performances must be attained in events open to any breed or Restricted to ASH only
- Points may only be claimed if a ribbon or prize is awarded unless otherwise noted in Points Table*
- Points are awarded for placing in finals only, not rounds
- Events for youth, junior, juvenile and the like are not acceptable under this section
- The Bonus Points for the Highest Placed ASH awards are only awarded in events open to any breed

Events in which Sport Section points can be obtained, include the following:

- Novelty/Barrel Racing/Flag Racing/Bending Racing
- Polocrosse
- Eventing*
- Showjumping
- Dressage

The grading and point score system, as well as any additional rules pertaining to individual disciplines are available in the individual point score table in Section 12.

4.7. YOUNG HORSE

General Rules

- Performances attained in events restricted to other breeds or registries are not acceptable. ALL
 performances must be attained in events open to any breed or Restricted to ASH only
- Points may only be claimed if a ribbon or prize is awarded
- Events for youth, junior, juvenile and the like are not acceptable under this section
- The 5 Bonus points for the Highest Placed ASH awards are only awarded in events open to any breed
- Age Criteria: 3 years of age and under in the year of nomination

Events, in which Young Horse Section points can be obtained, include the following events restricted by age:

- Led
- Show
- Performance
- Multi-Facet Futurity

The grading and point score system, as well as any additional rules pertaining to individual disciplines are available in the individual point score table in Section 12.

These rules are current as of 25/07/2016 and the committee reserves the right to alter or change at any time to ensure fair play.

General Rules

- Performances attained in events restricted to other breeds or registries are not acceptable. ALL
 performances must be attained in events open to any breed or Restricted to ASH only
- Points may only be claimed if a ribbon or prize is awarded
- Events for youth, junior, juvenile and under 18 are only acceptable under this section.
- The 5 Bonus points for the Highest Placed ASH awards are only awarded in events open to any breed

Events in which Youth Rider Section points can be obtained include the following:

- Show rider classes under 18 years
- Performance traditional youth ASHS classes
- Sport Eventing, Dressage, Show Jumping Novelties, Polocrosse etc
- Pony Club non-open age shows Combined Competitions, Pony Club high point awards, PCASA horse & rider event & PCASA member show classes
- EA competitions
- EA Interschool Competitions: eg Dressage, Show Jumping etc

The grading and point score system, as well as any additional rules pertaining to individual disciplines are available in the individual point score table in Section 12.

5. FEES

Nomination Fee: \$10 per horse per section, or \$50 for 6 sections (to be made in one payment)

6. RECORD KEEPING

Once the nomination has been accepted the owner/rider of the horse will be forwarded a point score booklet in which results are to be recorded.

In the instance of a horse attaining equal or divided placing in an event, the points pertaining to the highest place will be awarded. Both horses gain the same points.

7. SCORING RULES

- 1. Points gained prior to the horse being nominated are not valid.
- 2. Details of the show and each event where points are gained must be entered in the Point Score Booklet.
- 3. Points can only be attained in classified events open to any breed or restricted to ASH only.
- 4. Points may only be claimed if a ribbon or prize is awarded unless otherwise noted in the points table.
- 5. Points will be awarded in accordance with the Point Score Table and Rules for each section.
- 6. The Point Score Booklet must be returned to the SAMC before the nominated date marked on the booklet. When sending the Point Score Booklet to the SAMC, please keep a copy for your records.

Points may only be accumulated from the time of entry - no back dated events will be counted.

8. AWARDS, CERTIFICATES AND TROPHIES

Awards are achievable at the following levels:

^{*} Trophies will be given to the High Point Champion and to the Merit Award winner, except if a horse is awarded a Supreme Champion award or places in two different sections. Instead they will receive a Trophy for Supreme, or a Champion Trophy specifying their achievements. For Trophies to be presented there must be four or more horses nominated per section. If three or less horses are nominated per section, the High Point Champion & Merit Award winner will receive a trophy and voucher for that section. This does not apply to the Youth award.

9. OWNERS RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. To uphold The Australian Stock Horse Society Code of Conduct for Owners and Riders.
- 2. Owners are responsible for keeping their own Point Score Books and ensuring that details of each event are correctly noted.
- 3. The SAMC does not accept any responsibility for lost or damaged books or any disputes. It is suggested that owners keep a duplicate of their book at all times.
- 4. The SAMC will issue additional or replacement score books for a fee on request. The SAMC will not assist any owners in backtracking to obtain results or verification of results previously recorded in lost or damaged books.
- 5. Owners who have queries regarding show and event classifications should contact the SAMC

10. PROHIBITED DRUGS - NIL TOLERANCE POLICY

11. DISQUALIFICATION

Incorrectly claimed points will be disallowed. Any deliberate falsification of results may cause cancellation of part or all of that horse's recorded points and further action may be taken if the offence is in breach of the Society's Codes of Conduct or Rules and Regulations.
