RULES & REGULATIONS In accordance with the ASHS Ltd Handbook

* Youth events – Riders to be under 18 years. * All youth competing for Youth High Points ASHS Trophies must be a financial member or participant member of the ASHS and be on a Registered Australian Stock Horse. * Youth may compete as a Youth Competitor until the end of the ASHS SA Central Branch Show Season in which they turn 18. * Under 13 yrs, Youth Members (including participant), can compete on an unregistered mount in youth classes. * DRESS: as per ASH Society Ltd Events Handbook * All competitors to abide by the ASHS Ltd Handbook Rules * Novice ASH – A horse remains a novice until it has won three *Novices or an open class at any show, open gymkhana or similar event, except wins in youth or restricted age class. Maiden horses may compete in novice classes * WHIPS in led classes a show whip is permitted and must not exceed 77 centimetres in length. Dressage Whips & hacking canes not permitted in working classes. * All horses competing must be owned/leased by a financial Member of the Australian Stock horse Society Ltd. Persons under 18 yrs are not permitted to handle or ride Stallions or Colts. * ASHLA: (Australian Stock Horse Ladies' Association - open to all ASHLA members, proof of membership to be carried and produced upon request, ribbons awarded 1st - 3rd Riders 18 years & over, and ribbons awarded 1st- 3rd Riders 13 & under 18 years)
