A.S.H. Branch is inviting all South Australian ASH members to nominate eligible horse & rider combinations in one of the following categories for the 2015/2015 Camp Drafting season (1st July 2015 to 30th June, 2016) :- Junior / Juvenile / Encourage / Maiden / Novice / Open

- Horse must be ASH registered (Junior ASH Members under 13yrs exempt).
- Rider must belong to a South Australian ASH branch and be a current financial member of the ASHS.

- Competitor Status: Junior – Aged 8 years and under 13 years.
- Juvenile – 13 years and under 17 years
- Encourage/Maiden/Novice/Open – 17 years and over Points will be accrued from “date of nomination” and “from events” in the SCA South Australia Zone which includes the Keith & District, River Murray, Fleurieu, Lucindale & Flinders Ranges - Carrieton Campdrafts.

The High Point Awards will be presented during the 2016 SCA South Australian Campdraft Zone Annual Awards Dinner. Multiple horse nominations will be accepted from any rider providing membership & registration criteria are met. No cost to nominate – just an opportunity to compete for additional awards with registered ASH this season!
